The papers accepted cover a variety of topics, ranging from Cloud to Social Centric Networking, from Routing protocols to Delay Tolerant Networks.

Putting together *WiMobCity'14* was a team effort. We first thank the authors for providing the content of the program. We are grateful to the program committee members, who worked very hard in reviewing papers and providing feedback for authors. Finally, we also thank our sponsors and ACM MobiHoc for providing us the possibility to organize this workshop.

We hope that you will find this program interesting and thought-provoking and that the symposium will provide you with a valuable opportunity to share ideas with other researchers and practitioners from institutions around the world.
